



MATHS WORKSHEETS FOR CLASS 3 WORD PROBLEMS

WRITE THE ANSWER OF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS

- (1) Samuel baked 81 cakes. How many more cakes does Samuel have to bake to have 123 cakes?
- (2) Willy has 1,400 crayons. Lucy has 290 crayons. Jacob has 7 crayons. How many crayons do they have altogether?
- (3) Harry had 789 broomsticks, but he lost 243 of them. How many broomsticks does he have now?
- (4) There are 20 students in Grade 1, 54 students in Grade 2 and 76 students in Grade 3 in a School. What is the total number of students in the school combining all three Grades?
- (5) An archer had 156 bows. But he used 83 of them. How many bows is he left with now?
- (6) Chota Bheem likes eating fruits. He bought 15 apples, 18 pomegranates and 22 oranges. What is the total number of fruits he has now?
- (7) There were 870 passengers on a bus. At the next stop, 430 passengers got down at the next stop. How many passengers are there on the bus now?

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WORD PROBLEMS

CORRECT ANSWERS

- (1) The number of more cakes Samuel needs to bake
: $123 - 81 = 42$ cakes

- (2) Total number of crayons
: $1400 + 290 + 7 = 1697$ crayons

- (3) Number of broomsticks left
: $789 - 243 = 546$ broomsticks

- (4) The total number of students in the school combining all three Grades
: $20 + 54 + 76 = 150$ students

- (5) Number of bows he is left with now
: $156 - 83 = 73$

- (6) The total number of fruits he has now
: $15 + 18 + 22 = 55$ fruits

- (7) Number of passengers left on the bus
: $870 - 430 = 440$ passengers
